I felt proud because I always did well.”

Erica’s school has a music class that teaches students about composers and notes. Next year in third grade, she will get to revisit playing the recorder – something she is looking forward to very much. “Every student in my class will learn to play recorder. It’s different because I only

have music class at my school about every other week, and I’m sharing it with lots of other kids.”


Erica is a sweet, talented girl who loves Hello Kitty, Harry Potter and Disneyland. What advice does she have for her friends who want to learn music? “It may seem easy, but it takes hard work to do well. Do not give up even though it can get frustrating sometimes.” What Erica enjoys most about playing music is “knowing I’m good at doing something on my own.”
